

Dear colleagues

diagnosis and treatment of wrist disorders have developed very much during the last years. There are reliable treatment options for a number of standard situations. In daily practice however we encounter cases which do not fit precisely enough in our algorithms and which require all our knowledge of anatomy and kinematics.

Even for the skilled surgeon the way of decision making is not always simple and errors may occur. Sharing our experience, thorough discussion of treatment options and the theoretical backgrounds are important to treat these difficult cases successfully. Careful clinical examination and history are the prerequisites and should be taught and improved as well.

In 2008 we organized a clinically oriented workshop and a symposium the following day for the first time. Now we invite you to a second event of that kind. During the workshop we will practice together with experienced surgeons, to approach the patient from the clinical point of view with presentation of difficult cases and direct clinical examination of some patients in small groups. The own difficult cases brought as presentations by the participants are thought to be one of the main topics for discussion. In between practical aspects will be considered by means of a live surgeries.

On the next morning a symposium on wrist surgery mainly on the topics functional Anatomy, imaging, scapholunar ligament lesions, M. Kienböck and distal radioulnar joint will be held in Ludwigsburg.
